Revised Budget

Mr. Lamoureux reported that meetings have taken place with MTM and union representatives for the purpose of recommending budget cuts that would least impact on student services.

C-14/15-4 Revised Budget 2014-2015

WHEREAS in conformity with the Education Act, the Western Québec School Board has adopted its 2014-2015 budget (resolution C-13/14-335) containing a deficit in the amount of \$829 254;

WHEREAS the WQSB agrees to present a revised budget showing a deficit of \$390 857, and that this deficit is inferior to the authorized amount of \$404 000 of the Board's accumulated surplus on June 30, 2014, with the exception of the net accounting value of its land;

IT WAS MOVED by Commissioner R. Young that the revised 2014–2015 operating, capital and debt services budget showing a deficit of \$390 857 be adopted and forwarded to the Ministre de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport.
