



Homeschooling Letter of Understanding

Chapter 1, Article 15, paragraph (4) of the Education Act states that “a student who receives homeschooling and benefits from an educational experience which, according to an evaluation made by or for the School Board, is equivalent to what is provided at school is exempt from compulsory attendance.”

Taking this section of the Law into consideration, Western Québec School Board agrees to enter into a understanding with _____, parents/guardians of _____, to ensure that the education of their child is discharged adequately in accordance with the requirements of the Education Act.

As the parents/guardians agree to take personal, direct and legal responsibility for the education of their child for a maximum of one year, they undertake to provide at home, an educational experience which is deemed equivalent to, and in accordance with the Ministry of Education directives as outlined in the *Régime pédagogique* and the Québec Education Program.

The parents/guardians are responsible for contacting the school prior to the end of the Homeschooling understanding to arrange for an evaluation of the level of knowledge and progress attained. This may include an interview and presentation of portfolio, and any required tests for each of the subjects taught as agreed to in the Education Plan for Homeschooling annexed to this plan.

If for any reason the parents / guardians are unable to provide for the appropriate instruction during the school year, they are to notify the Board and return their child to school for placement in the most appropriate program in accordance with Western Québec School Board's procedures.
