C-16/17-166	WHEREAS school board elections are, by virtue of the School Elections Act, scheduled to be held in November 2018;
	WHEREAS the Quebec English School Boards Association (QESBA) endorses holding these elections in November 2018 as scheduled;
	WHEREAS the QESBA also recognizes that the provincial elections are to be held one month before the scheduled school elections;
	WHEREAS the QESBA believes that online voting for the next school elections would be beneficial for both voter turnout and for alleviating the long distance travel required for many English Quebecers;
	WHEREAS the QESBA would ask that the Ministre de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (MEES) and the Directeur général des élections du Québec (DGEQ) examine the option of a pilot project for online voting for all nine English school boards in Quebec;
	WHEREAS the QESBA also maintains that the issues surrounding the English electoral list be properly dealt with by the DGEQ in association with our nine member boards including solutions for graduating students and parents of former students having left our system;
	WHEREAS Québec is the only province in which school board and municipal elections are not twinned;
	BE IT RESOLVED that school elections should be held as designated by law in November 2018. If said elections should be postponed, the QESBA is requesting that a nomination process be put into place to

avoid a number of costly by-elections to fill seats vacated on the Council of Commissioners after November 2018;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that school board and municipal elections be twinned for the subsequent election cycle in 2021;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the MEES delegate the DGEQ to examine and implement a pilot project for online voting for the nine English school boards;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the DGEQ be mandated to seek concrete solutions in conjunction with our member boards to the issues surrounding the English electoral list;

IT WAS MOVED by Commissioner Guy that the Council support this resolution.
