### **BY-LAW NUMBER 30**

# BY-LAW ESTABLISHING DELEGATIONS OF POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE WESTERN QUÉBEC SCHOOL BOARD

### 1.0 PREAMBLE

The Council of Commissioners (the "Council") is the governing body of the Western Québec School Board (the "Board") and is vested with the functions and powers necessary to administer the affairs of the Board.

The Council maintains all powers and functions that are not delegated under this By-Law. As provided for by the Education Act, by this By-Law, Council delegates the powers and functions described in Appendix A.

### 2.0 GENERAL PROVISIONS

This by-law confers upon the delegatees full responsibility for the powers and functions delegated to them and extend to any action required in the exercise thereof or resulting there from.

The delegatees shall exercise the powers and perform the functions delegated to them subject to the budget and policies of the Board and the collective agreements in force.

Delegatees are accountable for their decisions and must report back to the appropriate authorities. Information regarding all personnel changes must be sent to all commissioners.

Once delegated by the Council, functions and powers delegated by Council cannot be sub-delegated.

As provided for in the Education Act, the Assistant Director General may exercise the powers and functions delegated to the Director General if he/she is absent or unable to act.

Appendix A contained herein forms an integral part of this by-law.

### 3.0 EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

Council recognizes that in an unforeseen emergency situation, the Director General may take measures necessary to ensure the security of students, staff and the members of the public, and to protect the property and the rights of the Board. The Director General will report to Council on all decisions taken as a result of the application of this section.

### 4.0 COMING INTO FORCE
