Re-write Final Examinations

In addition to these summer school tutorials, there will be re-write final examinations for the following subjects:

- Grade 10: Science & the Environment 402 [extra science]
- Grade 11: English, French, Math, Chemistry 504 & Physics 504

These re-write exams will be available to students who did not pass the course or who wish to upgrade their final mark. To **qualify for a re-write final examination**, the student **MUST** have previously taken the course during this academic school year. Rewrites will be written at the same time as the regular scheduled exams. Registration will still be needed under the **REWRITE ONLY** section.

Final Marks – June 2026

Grade 10 Math and Science, as well as Grade 11 English and French, have Ministry exams. Final marks for these courses are set by the Ministry (not the school) and will be sent home on the official Ministry Statement of Marks in early July 2026. These marks will not appear on the final school report card.

All other course marks are determined by the school and will be available on the June report card in the portal by late June 2026.

Please note that students may need to register for summer school before receiving all final marks. If a course is later found to be unnecessary, a full refund will be issued. Families can also contact the school or summer school to inquire about results if needed.

Ministry Requirements for Graduation

Students must accumulate 54 credits, 20 of which must be at the Secondary V level. **The compulsory credits are:**

- Secondary 5/Grade 11 English† (6 credits)
- Secondary 5/ Grade 11 French† (4 credits)
- Secondary 4/Grade 10 Mathematics† (4 credits or 6 credits)
- Secondary 4/ Grade 10 Science and Technology† (4 credits) or Applied Science and Technology† (6 credits)
- Secondary 4/ Grade 10 History of Quebec and Canada† (4 credits)
- Secondary 4/Grade 10 Arts Education (2 credits)
- Secondary 5/ Grade 11 Ethics and Religious Culture or Physical Education and Health (2 credits)
